To Whom It May Concern:

The Marietta Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee has been open for applications on a year-round basis. There is a cut-off date of January 28, 2021 for applications to be processed for the upcoming interview for a possible class in 2021. All interested applicants must start the application at the Ohio Means Jobs – Washington County 1115 Gilman Ave., Suite B, Marietta, Ohio 45750. All Applicants must apply in person and fully meet the following minimum qualifications to qualify for an interview:

A pool of eligible applicants shall be established consisting of individuals who qualify for oral interview.

To qualify for oral interview an applicant must meet the following basic requirements unless he or she has worked a minimum of four thousand (4000) hours specifically in the electrical construction trade.

- a. Be a minimum of 17 years of age.
- b. Be at least a high school graduate, or have a GED, or have a two-year Associate Degree or higher.
- c. Show evidence of successful completion of: One full credit of high school algebra with a passing grade, or one post high school algebra course with a passing grade.
- d. Provide an official transcript for high school, post high school education and training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
- e. Submit a DD214 to verify military training and/or experience if they are a veteran and wish to receive consideration for training/experience.
- f. Qualify for interview by obtaining a minimum qualifying score of 4 using the WorkKeys® Applied Math Practice Test and WorkKeys® Workplace Documents Practice Test.
- g. Present evidence that they possess a valid driver's license.

- h. Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- i. Prior to being indentured, applicants selected from the pool of interviewed applicants will be required to provide results of a physical examination and a drug test as decided by the JATC.

All applicants will be required to pay a processing fee of \$20.00.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship, shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older. The applicant must meet the minimum age requirement. The sponsor will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in apprenticeship and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under applicable law and lawful regulations issued thereunder.

Applicants who meet all basic requirements will be interviewed by the J.A.T.C. Apprentices will be selected in order of their final ranking.
