What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a combination of on the job training (OJT) and classroom instruction. You will have the benefit of working side-by-side with seasoned Journeyman Wireman as you learn the trade. Additionally, as an apprentice you will earn a living wage while receiving a free college education in the evenings.

What are the program specifics?

- ◆ 5 year apprenticeship program
 - * Minimum of 960 Hours Classroom Instruction and 8000 OJT
 - * Class in the evenings 1-2 nights per week with summers off
- ◆ Earn a living wage while developing a career path
- ◆ Receive college credit at no cost to you

How can I apply?

You will need to apply in person at the Washington County - Ohio Means Jobs. They will assist you with the application packet, and proctor the aptitude test.

You Will Need:

- Official transcripts in a sealed envelope, faxed, or emailed directly to mejatc@ibew972.org
 - * Must be a high school graduate or equivalent (or a senior on the path to graduate)
 - * You must have passed one year of high school algebra.
- Valid Drivers License—*Minimum of 17 years old (18 when indentured)*
- DD-214 (if you have a military background)
- Optional / Encouraged:
 - Resume, Letters of Recommendation, Awards, Certificates, Diploma, Social Security Card, etc.*

After completing the process at Ohio Means Jobs, you will contact the Training Center to schedule a time to complete the application process and pay a \$20 processing fee.
